Lord Moira, with his humblest duty, informs
Your Royal Highness that Lord Bellesley
this afternoon made in the House of
Lords a statement of the unprosperous ter-
-mination of the negotiation. It appear-
-ed to be the decided sense of the House
that no details should there be laid be-
-fore them; obviously, from the fear that

such an exposition might prevent the reser-
-val of treaty. but till the effect of what has
taken place in the two Houses shall be
ascertained, which cannot be the case
before tomorrow morning, I do herein most
respectfully submit to your royal
Highness that all proceedings rest
passe.
