and that Sir Ralph Milbank Baronet the other representative
be requested to accompany him on the occasion

That the address with these resolutions be
once advertised in the Newcastle Courant and the York
Herald and also in the Courier and the Morning Chronicle

That the thanks of the meeting be given to
Sir Henry Vane Tempest for his attendance and for
obligingly undertaking to present the address.
