My Lord,

I had not the Honour to receive your
Lordships letter of the 10th till yesterday; as it was
brought by Rowley, it could not reach me sooner.

I must intreat your Lordship to
lay me most respectfully at the feet of His Royal
Highness the Prince Regent.

I have at present no other House
I can inhabit, but Park Place, having let mine in
London & this from which I write, being in a very
unfinish'd state. It never was my intention under any
circumstances to let Park Place - yet had the circumstances
been different I should have considered the wishes of A. H. as
his commands & with every feeling of duty & respect
submitted to them.
