I feel it my duty to inform you, that I shall resign to your Grace the Living of Thelghap at the approach of Michaelmas, the Prince Regent having most graciously pleased to promote me to the Archbishopric of London, which has become void by the elevation of Dr. Saur to the See of Exeter.

Having long had reason to expect that a handsome provision would be



made for me in the English Church  
I naturally avoided the troublesome  
task of building a Globe House at  
Tholylops which I could not do  
and from which there was great prob-  
ability of my removal before its com-  
pletion. This is the best apology that  
I can make to your Grace for my tardy  
ness in effecting this object of your  
wishes. — For the and oblige me with  
what you have so kindly favoured me  
as my Diocesan I request that you  
will receive my most grateful acknow-  
ledgements. — I have the Honour to be
