My Dear Sir

I beg leave to have the honor of stating to you that Mr Perrin whom at my request you so kindly visited yourself has met with a severe and serious accident. he was on his way to Dublin in order to join his Regt two miles this side of Limerick five armed ruffians stopped the Chaise on his footpath I must say making resistance they fired and wounded him severely in his shoulder and chest. under this misfortune it will not be possible for him to join his Regt for many months. I shall therefore consider as a very great favour indeed your having the goodness to recommend my nephew Mr Samuel Garner to be Surgeon in the 67 Regt in the room of Mr Perrin for whom I will purchase an Ensigny

When he recovers - I am particularly desirous
to get my nephew into the 67. Regt as he is
known to Sir George Nugent - requesting you
will cause this liberty -
