My Dear Adam

I was with S. Liverpool  
at the time you called upon me,  
I was talking to him upon your  
subject.

He has desired me to  
tell you that his very anxious wish  
had been to treat you with the most  
marked favour that the Law would  
permit, but that the Bill of last  
Year is so conclusive against the  
Power

Power of doing more for you than for  
any other Embassador, that he has  
only to express his great regrets at not  
having the means of carrying his wishes  
for you into effect. If anything sh<sup>d</sup>  
suggest itself to you as likely to afford  
such means, you know that I shall  
have the greatest pleasure in exerting  
myself to the utmost, & I can answer  
for it that whatever in Law might  
be practicable I. L. w. readily
