I presume to send this Account as it may afford you a just Satisfaction to know how properly one of your Generals conducted himself to the last moments of his life—in your Service and that of his Country.

Should your Royal Highness condescend to honor the enclosed with your Perusal—may I request when you have done so, it may be returned to Me, as his Family will naturally wish to preserve the Letter.
