Sir

I beg leave to acquaint you that very great inconvenience will accrue to the Publick Service, unless the signature of His Royal Highness the Prince Regent can speedily be obtain'd to the instrument upon which a Privity Seal of 2,000,000 is to be grounded for the Navy. An issue will be wanted in a very short time, and the Privity Seal will have to be sent into the Country to Lord Westmoreland after His Royal Highness shall have given the Authority for making it out. The instrument in question was some time ago transmitted to Carleton House, but thro' mistake return'd without the Royal Signature, which induc'd the necessity of sending it back again.
