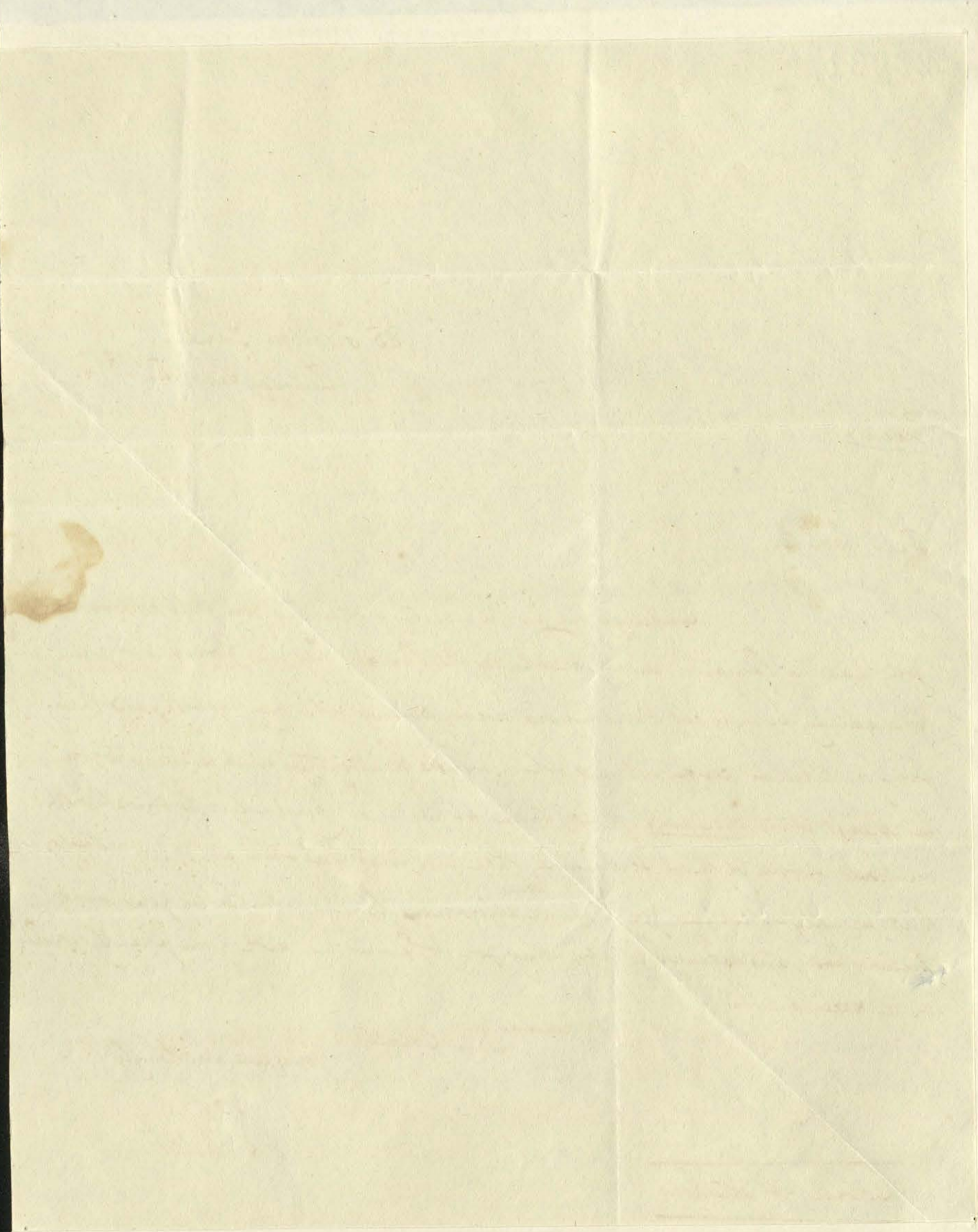
Dear Colonel,
