I have the honor to inform You, that I have received a Letter from North America acquainting me under the date of the 27th August last from Newtown Long Island, that an Order has been issued that all English families are to quit the United States on or before the 27th December next.

I expect Admiral Bentinck's Return, from Prussia every day, and as I have given him a Letter of Introduction at his particular Request to the Crown Prince of Sweden, he will be a competent Judge from the reception he has received, and the subsequent proceedings, what reliance may be placed on our Allies in the North of Europe. Happy am I to learn that the Cheltenham Waters have produced a salutary effect and that You enjoy Health. God preserve You and believe me with sincere Respect,
