Declaration of the  
Members of Her  
Majesty's Council  
respecting the State  
of His Majesty's  
Health.

We the Underwritten Members of the Council appointed to assist Her Majesty in the Execution of the Trusts committed to Her Majesty by virtue of the Statute passed in the 55<sup>th</sup> Year of His Majesty's Reign intituled "An Act to provide for the Administration of the Royal Authority, and for the Care of His Majesty's Royal Person during the Continuance of His Majesty's Illness and for the Resumption of the Exercise of the Royal Authority by His Majesty" having duly met together on this 2<sup>d</sup> Day of April 1814 at The Queens Lodge near to Windsor Castle, and having called before Us and examined upon Oath the Physicians and other Persons attendant upon His Majesty, and having ascertained the State of His Majesty's Health by all such other ways and means as appeared to Us to be necessary for that Purpose Do hereby declare and certify That the State

of

of His Majesty's Health at the time of  
this our Meeting is not such as to  
enable His Majesty to resume the  
Personal Exercise of His Royal  
& Authority: His Majesty's bodily  
Health is very good. His Majesty's  
Mental Health is as much disordered  
as it has been at any period during  
His Majesty's Indisposition. His  
Majesty's Physicians do not expect  
His Majesty's Recovery They represent  
that such Recovery is not impossible  
and therefore that they do not  
despair of it. -
