 Declaration of the  
 the Members of the  
 Queen's Council  
 respecting the State  
 of His Majesty's  
 Health.

We the Undersigned, Members of the  
 Council appointed to assist Her  
 Majesty in the Exercise of the Trusts  
 committed to Her Majesty, by virtue  
 of the Statute passed in the 51.<sup>st</sup> Year  
 of His Majesty's Reign intituled --  
 "An Act to provide for the Administration  
 " of the Royal Authority, and for the Care  
 " of His Majesty's Royal Person during  
 " the Continuance of His Majesty's Illness,  
 " and for the Resumption of the exercise  
 " of the Royal Authority by His Majesty"  
 having duly met together on this  
 second Day of July 1814 at The Queens  
 Lodge near Windsor Castle, and  
 having called before Us and ~~and~~  
 examined upon Oath the Physicians  
 and other Persons attendant upon  
 His Majesty, and having ascertained  
 the state of His Majesty's Health by  
 all <sup>other</sup> such Ways and means as appeared  
 to Us to be necessary for this purpose  
 Do hereby declare and Certify That

The

State of His Majesty's Health at the  
time of this our Meeting is as  
follows.

That His Majesty's Health  
is not such as to enable His Majesty  
to resume the Personal Exercise of  
His Royal Authority.

His Majesty's mental Health  
continues to be as much disordered  
as it has been at any time during  
his indisposition. —

His Majesty's bodily Health  
is good —

The Physicians in attendance  
upon His Majesty do not expect His  
Majesty's Recovery, but such recovery  
not being impossible, they state that  
therefore they do not despair of it.
