Cavendish Square 6th January 1776.

I have read with the deepest concern the Papers transmitted from Ireland, which your Majesty has been pleased to communicate to me, and which I herewith return. I am humbly of opinion that the surviving Officers of the 32^d Regiment should be allow'd as much as on any former occasion of the like nature has ever been ever allow'd; and that it should be paid by England. I am happy to find that a Transport will be provided in Ireland, so as to prevent any delay of the Expedition under Lord Cornwallis.

In consequence of your Majesty's gracious permission I propose going to Beckett tomorrow, determining to return the moment I am wanted in London.
