Mr Robinson has the Honour to submit to His Majesty by Lord North's orders, two Papers which Mr Robinson received from Lord North just as he was leaving Busby Park, about three quarters of an Hour ago, where he left. The Attorney General, Mr Jenkinson, Mr Cornwall, and Mr. Martin, and to whom he returns very early to morrow Morning. Lord North received the Letter & Paper from Sir Philip Gibbs to Day, and being engaged with the above Gentlemen at Busby Park to morrow, and having by a previous Appointment

fixed to see Mr Forth on Thursday Morning - His
Lordship fears that he cannot see Sir Philip
Gibbes until Thursday Evening, when he has
directed Mr Robinson to write Mr Philip to appoint
him, and which Mr Robinson accordingly does to Night.
