The Bishop of Landaff, in the warmest sense of duty, begs leave most humbly to represent to The King, that, he has been near nine years on the episcopal bench, with an ecclesiastical income, at no part of that period, of more than £1500, at present with only £1050; that, he submitted, as became him, without complaint, in the promotion of two of his juniors; but, from His Majesty's goodness he is induced to hope that no junior, not already in possession of such a bishopric as the Bishop of Landaff would thankfully accept, will in future be preferred before him; and trusts he shall be forgiven if he presumes to express a wish, that, His Majesty will be graciously pleased to think of him for one of the more considerable sees, when such shall be vacant.
