

St. Anne's New Oct. 6th 1829

At an adjourned Vestry of the Inhabitants of this Parish from the 2nd Instant, for the purpose of receiving the Report of the Churchwarden relating to the disposal of the windows presented to the Parish by His Majesty.

It having been communicated to the Vestry by the Churchwarden, that the windows which His Majesty was graciously pleased to give for the use of the Church (but which have been reported by the Surveyor as unsuited to the object) may be made available to some other purpose within the contemplation of Sir Jeffrey Wyatville for His Majesty's use.

It was Resolved.

"That the Parish gladly avail themselves of this opportunity to renew the assurance to His Majesty of their unfeigned gratitude for the many munificent donations of His Majesty to this Parish and to request permission at the same time to place the windows which His Majesty was so graciously pleased to bestow at His Majesty's disposal for whatever purpose His Majesty may be pleased to assign them."
