Mr. Robinson has the Honour to send to Your Majesty the Dispatches received from St. Lucie yesterday afternoon; and he begs leave to mention to your Majesty that the Provisions so much complained of, are the Cargoes of those three Victuallers, which laid so many Months in the West Indies waiting for the arrival of the Troops. Their Inconveniencies, however, must be intirely removed by the other Fleet having arrived safe
