Lord North has the honour of inclo-  
-sing a number of papers received  
from the Lord Lieutenant of Ireland  
respecting his want of money with  
a letter from Lord North to his Excellen-  
cy on that subject. Notwithstanding  
what Lord North has written, he  
submits to his Majesty, whether in  
this moment it will not be proper for  
the messenger who carries the letter

to take with him a sum of £10,000  
to answer immediate exigencies  
in case the Kingdom of Ireland should  
be ready in that other want of money  
which the Lord Lieutenant & his  
Secretary represent. unless Lord  
Buckingham can alledge very substan-  
-tial & very ostensible reasons to  
the contrary, Lord North is of opinion  
that a grant of British money must  
be accompanied with a Proclama-  
-tion for calling the Irish Parliament.
