Ld. North has the honour of informing
to his Majesty two more letters of
intelligence; From all those which
Ld. North has seen, He is led to conclude
that the sailing of the Cadiz fleet is
absolutely certain, & that it is highly
probable that almost the whole of it
is destined to join Mr D'Orville's, a
few ships of the line only being kept
back to block up Gibraltar, & prevent
the entry of any fresh supplies.
