 the next place I Give and bequeath to my loving

 my Real and personal Estate and effects whatsoever
 and wheresoever and all monies in the Funds and
 all my Household Furniture Goods Plate Linen
 China Wearing apparel Jewels Trinkets and all other
 my Estate and effects whatsoever and wheresoever which
 I may be possessed of or entitled to at the time of my decease
 But Subject nevertheless to the payment of the several
 Legacies hereinafter by me given viz. to William Henry
 Augustus Fitzstathern late of the City of Edinburgh
 Esquire the Sum of Two thousand pounds to Henry
 Lyte of George Street in Adelphi London Esquire the
 Sum of One thousand pounds And to Henry Cope of
 Wilson Street Gray's Inn Road London (my present
 Solicitor) the Sum of Five hundred pounds And
 whereas I am in possession of divers secret papers of
 the Marriage of my late Uncle George the Third which
 I Will and desire my Executors hereinafter named not to
 part with unless the Sum of Fifty thousand pounds
 be given or procured for the same; And in case the said
 Sum of Fifty thousand pounds should be obtained
 for them then I Will and dispose of the said Sum of
 Fifty thousand pounds in manner following viz: the
 Sum of Fifteen thousand pounds part of the said Sum of
 Fifty thousand pounds to my said Daughter Lavinia

his Executors Administrators and Assigns the Sum of Five
thousand pounds and the remaining Sum of Twenty
thousand pounds to be equally divided between my
said Daughter Lavinia Janetta Horton Serres, the said
William Henry Augustus Fitzstrathern and the said
Henry Cope making together the Sum of Fifty thousand
pounds And I do hereby nominate constitute and
appoint my said Daughter Lavinia Janetta Horton
Serres, the said William Henry Augustus Fitzstrathern
Henry Gow Clough of Norton Street Fitzroy Square
London and Sir Gerard Noel of Heston Park
in the County of Rutland Baronet my Executors
And I do hereby revoke all former or other Wills
by me at any time heretofore made and do declare this
to be my last Will and Testament In witness whereof
I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal the fifteenth
day of November in the Year of our Lord one thousand
Eight hundred and twenty one.
