Mr George Harrison has the Honor, by the desire of Sir William Vane, to hand to His Excellency Count Munster the following papers, viz:

No. 1 - a Draft in English of the proposed Security to the House of Rothschild and Sons of Frankfurt for one hundred and Twenty five thousand Pounds on His Majesty's Hannoverian Revenues - to which His Royal Highness the Duke of York is made a Party.

No. 2 Is a Draft of the same Security which has been translated into the German Language by Mr Rothschild from the English Draft (No. 1) and sent to Mr Harrison by Mr Rothschild when he returned the English Draft approved by him.

No. 3 Is a blank Sheet of Paper, with the proper Stamp upon which is to be written the original Security in German from His

His Majesty and the Duke of York.
Mr. Harris, Secy. to the Exchequer, Count Munster
that he is informed by Mr. Rothschild that
upon the former occasion, the Security was
signed in Duplicate by His Majesty - the
original in a Stamp - and other Papers
a Paper unstamped - the former was sent
to Frankfurt and the other was retained
by Mr. Rothschild in London. - That
Government is desirous that a similar
course should be pursued on the present
occasion. - If His Excellency Count Munster
should be pleased to approve and adopt
the form which has been prepared in
Germany by Mr. Rothschild, that Paper
may be submitted for His Majesty's and
the Duke of York's Signature - as the part

unstamped Paper, and would save the
trouble of preparing another Instrument.

do him the favor to accept the assurance
of his high respect.
