I most humbly submit to your Majesty, as the Season is so far advanced, that The Dragoons may be ordered into their winter Quarters; and if it meets with your Majesty's Approbation, I would immediately dispatch the Orders: I don't imagine any discontent or displeasure will arise amongst that Corps, but as they are the first to suffer by the advanced Season, and can be more readily assembled than the Infantry, in case the Service should require it, I am humbly of opinion it may be best

for

for your Majesty's Service, to
send them into their intended
Quarters. I beg leave to enclose
a Letter I received from Lord
Chancellor, last night, with a
copy of my answer thereto.
