TEMPORARY ARRANGEMENT for the Investiture of the MOST NOBLE ORDER OF THE GARTER, at the ROYAL CASTLE OF WINDSOR, till the State Apartments are completed; it being the intention of the SOVEREIGN that all future Investitures should take place there.

The Knights Companions will put on their Mantles and Collars in the Queen's Dining-room, and will then assemble in the Green Drawing-room, where they will be called over by Garter, and proceed into the presence of the Sovereign in the Royal Closet (or White Drawing-room), the Senior Knights first, followed by the Officers of the Order.

Then being again called over, a Procession will be made from the Royal Closet through the Green Drawing-room (which will be lined by the Prebends, and the Naval and Military Knights of Windsor) into the Red Drawing-room or Chapter-room, in the following Order, being according to the Order of their Stalls in the Royal Chapel of St. George at Windsor.

N. B.—The Knights whose Companions are not present, will walk in the Procession alone.
