Agreed that Lord North do propose to Parliament
to grant to Ireland the Exportation of Woollen
Manufactures, Glass and Stops, and to open
the Trade of Ireland to and from the British
Colonies in America & Settlements in Africa.
Provided that this shall not extend to any Privileges
in Trade which may be vested in any exclusive
Company, but that all the Articles of Commerce
above referred to shall be and remain subjected
to the

the same Restrictions and Burthens as the same
shall be liable to in the Island of Great Britain
