The Despatches which are just arrived from Mr Joseph Yorke seemed to require an immediate answer. I have added to the Despatch I had prepared such a one as occurs in the moment to me, and submit ^{it} to your Majesty's consideration, humbly hoping that I shall receive yr commands with respect to the language I am to hold to it to holden. Little inconvenience would arise from a Delay of three weeks, but there seem to me strong objections to the acquiescing in a Demand made in the manner in which this comes, and was accompanied with any friendly assurance
