The Duke of Portland acquainted the House that the Papers not being ready to be laid before the House he had nothing further to trouble their Lordships with. As Mansfield being previously apprized of it immediately Adjourned the House therefore no word was said in reply -

The Duke of P. & I had a great deal of conversation as I had also with Dr Keppel & Dr Loughborough well as you I believe the Messengers will be back with the D. of P. by six this evening my Opinion is the K will write word he will not trouble the D. as he shall see him tomorrow at St. James's -
