My Lord

I was this day honoured with your Lordships Letter of Dismission from the Service of H. R. H. accompanied with a Copy of his gracious Letter to your Lordship. I cannot but lament the occasion that has forced his R. H. to this Step - which though severe on us all, we must yet applaud. Nor can I have any thing further to say - but to beg, should an opportunity offer, and your Lordship not think it improper - you - would lay me at his R. H.'s Feet, & beg that I may still be permitted to approach his Person to testify my most grateful sense, for all his goodness, & condescension towards me during the time I had the honour of belonging to him, and may I add, shall still esteem myself honoured, flattered, and happy by his Commands
