Sandles House was then quelled and every thing seemed to be quiet for the moment. There has been no Intelligenc^e rec^d to day of any fresh outrage, but there will be immediately a Meeting here of yo^r Majesty's Confidential Servants to see if any thing further can be done for the preservation of the Publick Peace.
