Lord North has the honour of in-  
forming his Majesty, that he  
has sent to Mr Wedderburn to  
acquaint him that it is his Ma-  
jesty's pleasure, that he should  
keep hands today; He has also  
written to the Lord Chancellor  
to inform him of Lord Chief Justice  
De Grey's resignation; He believes that  
if Mr Wedderburn should keep his

His Majesty's hand today. There will be time  
enough to complete the rest of the  
business before the end of the  
Term even though some delay  
should arise from the absence  
of the Chancellor.

Lord North supposes that he may  
inform Mr Wallace of His Majesty's inten-  
-tion to appoint him Attorney General,  
& that he may resign his Majesty's office  
the place of Solicitor General to  
Mr Mansfield.
