The Prince of Wales

Sept. 30. 1791.

As His Royal Highness the Duke of
York is very uncertain whether He shall be
able to find time to write himself to
Your Royal Highness by the Estafette Mr
Swart is going to dispatch this evening,
He has commanded me to acquaint
you, that He was married yesterday
evening, & at the same time to express
to yr Royal Highness His feelings of
gratitude & affection for the kind and
fraternal manner in which you have

behav^r towards him on this occasion. He
will certainly write to your Royal Highness
by Sunday's post -

No part of the different ceremonies
customary at this Court when any of the
Royal Family marry were omitted and
His Prussian Majesty seem'd to take particular
pains to give as much splendor and
magnificence to the Ceremony itself as
possible - I have had the pleasure to see
this morning both the Duke & Duchess of
York, perfectly well & happy beyond
description.
