I beg Leave to Incline for your peculiar Information the prin-  
cipals and leading Circumstances of our present Situation,  
every Effort of the Enemy will be made to retake this place  
and I trust we may be able to resist with Success — I  
arrived here on the same Day that Genl. O'Hara came in from  
Siberia — Hitherto I have held out pretty well under more  
difficulty and Exertion than I thought I was able to Com-  
bat but I certainly ought not unnecessarily to Court an extraordinary  
Share of either
