the Governor's House at Portsmouth by nine
on Monday Morning. I am not sure whether
it will be possible to bring ^{the} Col. later: for
his Regiment is ordered for immediate ex-

- embarkation, - I know not yet whether he
may not by that time be obliged to join the
Admiral under whose Command he is to sail.

As I shall so soon be able to explain that
Expedition verbally to Your Royal Highness,
I will not say any thing respecting it now.

Sir William had some thoughts of sitting out
yesterday for Weymouth, in which case he
would scarcely be back by Monday. I write
to him, however, at Portsmouth: but his absence
need not alter the place of meeting. I likewise
