

Apr. 4 1796

An Account of the Repairs wanting to be done at the Grange pursuant to the Lease granted to His Royal Highness the Prince of Wales, by the Trustees of the late Henry Drummond Esq^r

March 1796

To repair the Tops of the Chimnies and the Lead Works on the Roof of the House

To repair some Brickwork and Pavement about the Offices

To alter and repair the Sashes to the South Front, so as to keep out the Weather, to fit and case the Shutters and inside Linings to refit all the outside Doors Windows about the House and Offices

To paint all the Wood and Iron Work on the outside of the House and Offices

To reset repair and clean some of the outside Steps and Pavements

At the Bath House in the Park the same sort of repair and painting wanting - the Roof new thatched

At the Bridge near the Bath House the decayed part of it to repair and the whole of the Bridge pointed as it has before been done

At the Farm Yard the Roof of the Dove House to strip and new tile, the ^{Cart} ~~Couch~~ House Stable to enclose the sides with a Brick Wall and repair the doors & Windows

The weather boarding and other wood Work about the different Buildings require some Repairs

All the outside wood and Iron work which had before been pointed requires to be done again

At the Stable the Tiling wants repairing, some Repairs to the Windows, the outside doors and spaving & the outside wood and Iron Work want painting

At the Hot House and Conservatory some outside
Repairs are wanting, and the outside work pointing
Outside pointing is wanted to gates & different
Buildings

It will be necessary to lay out £600 to complete
these Repairs in a good & effectual manner
