Palace Hampton Court 18<sup>th</sup> April 1797

May I entreat you to lay before His Royal Highness the Prince of Wales my humble acknowledgements for his Condescension and Goodness, and to assure H. R. H. that I shall not certainly hold myself in readiness to obey his very gracious Commands.

I am very sorry that I miss'd the satisfaction of seeing you this morning; but I purpose returning to town on Thursday, and intend myself the honor of waiting upon you at Carlton House on that day at 4 o'clock.
