My Dear General

The conversation yesterday at the House of Lords between Dr. Threlkeld, the Chancellor, & me, could only be in general terms. As the enclosed letter had prescribed that no step should be prematurely taken. All, therefore, that I could gather was a very fair disposition on the part of the Chancellor

to give all advantage to the claim when
the mode of enjoying it shall be determined
upon. The Prince requests that you
will in his name get the Duke of
Cleveland to recommend to the Bishop
of Chester Doctor Grey's application
to succeed to the living which he has
