The Prince of Wales has received the Lord Chancellor's
Communication of the 26th Instant, in which He
observes the following "With regard to the Verbal
"Answers to the Questions addressed to those Gentlemen
"by His Royal Highness on the 10th of June, His Majesty's
"Servants humbly request ^{of} permission to refer His
"Royal Highness to the Physicians themselves for the
"true meaning of those answers, which appear to
"have been understood by His Royal Highness in a
"sense different from that, which, it has been
"represented to His Majesty's Servants, was intended to
be conveyed.
