My dear Sir

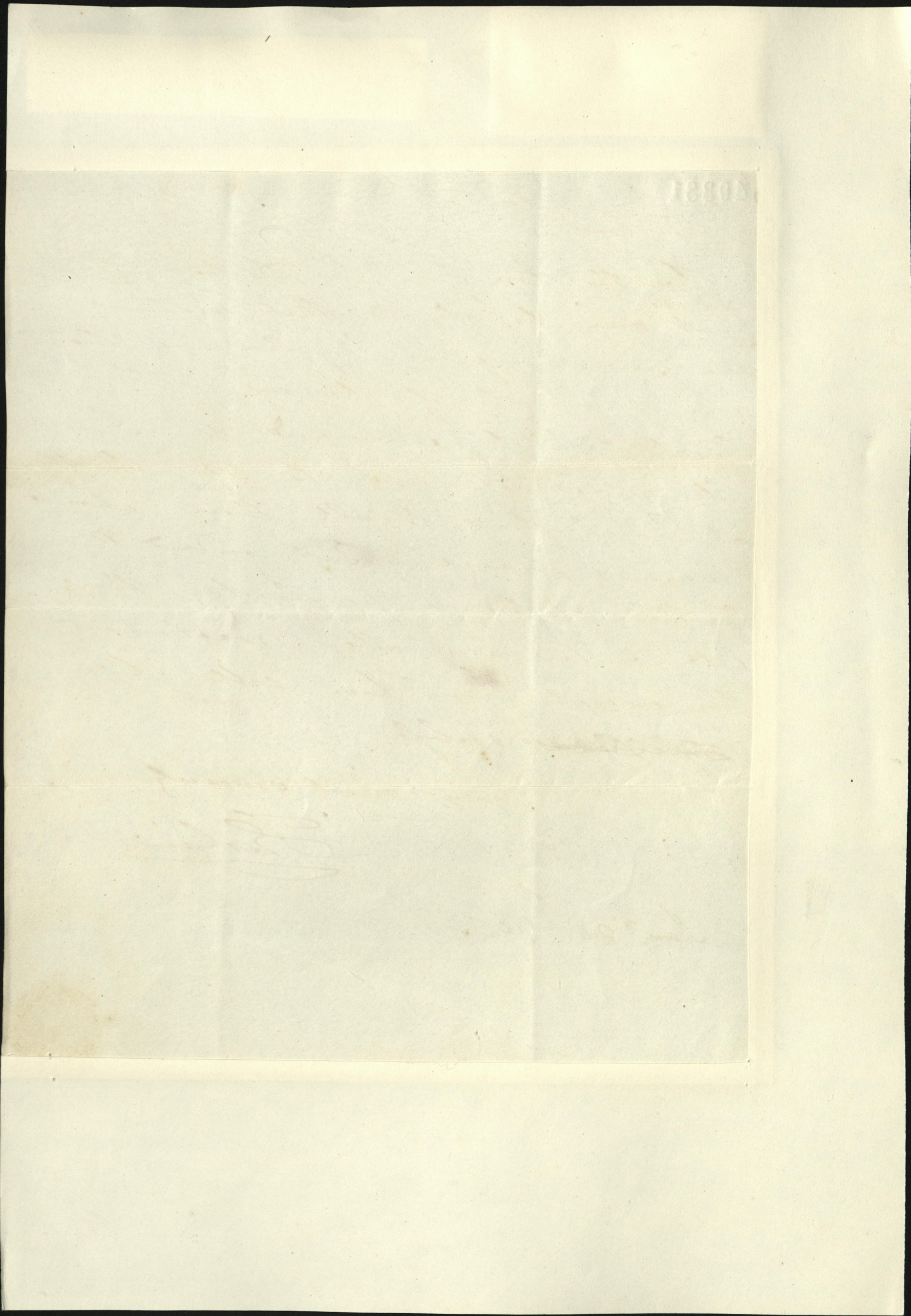
I beg that thro you the Duke of
