These are to Authorize you by beat of Drum or otherwise, to raise so many Men in any County within that part of Our United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland called Great Britain, as are, or shall be wanting to Recruit and fill up the respective Companies of Our Regiment of Foot under your Command, to the numbers allowed upon the Establishment: And all Magistrates, Justices of the Peace, Constables, and other Our Civil Officers whom it may concern, are hereby required to be assisting unto you, in providing Quarters, Impressing Carriages, and otherwise as there shall be occasion. And for so doing this Our Order shall be and continue in force for twelve Months from the 25th day of March next.

Given at Our Court at St. James's this 2^d day of February 1805 in the 4th Year of Our Reign.
