Your letter of Yesterdays date and its
enclosures relative to the state of the Horses of the
Kings Dragoon Guards, having been laid before the
Commander in Chief. — I have His Royal
Highness's commands to desire that the Exchange
of Quarters intended between this Regiment, and the
Enniskilling Dragoons, may not take place,
unless the Veterinary Surgeon General has
been able to ascertain whether from the Glanders
having prevailed among the Horses of the
first mentioned Corps, it will be safe to move
them into Brighton Barracks
