On returning from hunting I have found Lord North's letter accompanying one from Lord Chesterfield on the subject of the Lieutenancy of the County of Bucks, likely to be vacant within a few days by the death of Lord Le Despencer; undoubtedly Lord Chesterfield's political conduct deserves a preference to that of Lord Temple, and I certainly will never again appoint to one of those Offices any one whose sentiments are not cordial with the Government; I shall therefore certainly decide in favour of Lord Chesterfield; perhaps less cordially from private reasons than I should have done some months ago.
