The Refugees express the strongest resentment
and alarm about the 10th Article of the Capitulation.
St. Henry Clinton has endeavored to
appease them by an order to let his Port
be in case of surrender the commanding
officer is to agree to no terms without including
the Refugees with them. St. James Hood, sailed
the 12th of November from Long's Hook, the
French Fleet sailed from Chesapeake the 6th.

with Mr Samuel Hood.
