Lord North, having declared to those who are to
form an Administration that no provision would be
made but for you and Mr. Robinson, to which I must
add the assurance given to Sir Thomas Paken four
years ago must also be added: I certainly ^{not} would say
more; I never meant to say that £2000. a year ought
to be the provision for a Secretary of the Treasury
but thinking Sir Gray Cooper had that I was of opinion
that Mr. Robinson who has had all the labour was
entitled to, which ever office of business is fixed on
for him his Provision should cease when he comes
to enjoy it; the Reversion must be his own life
and that of his son in Law, the remaining in Part.
when such an event happens cannot be an object
to him.

Lord North will write this Morning to the Secretary
of State Office that the Warrant be prepared
appointing Dr. Dempster Dean of Rochester and Dr.

James Cannon of Windsor.

I must just add all further Applications
for Officers reversion, &c. must now cease.
