My Lord, The whole tenour of Your conduct has so manifestly  
shews that Attachment to my Devron, to Your Country, and to  
the Military Profession ~~are~~ the motives of Your Actions  
that I am certain no fresh proof is necessary to the  
World for justice to be done You on that head. I  
therefore must desire You not from a false delicacy  
to think of resigning the Office of Constable of  
the Tower of London.

Had not a multiplicity of business prevented me  
Your very handsome Offer should have remained  
so many days unnotic'd
