The House of Commons went to day into
the Committee upon the Bill for preventing
Revenue Officers from voting at Elections.
Sir Francis Bapet proposed to exempt
all the present Officers from the Disability
incurred by the Bill, and divided the
Committee upon his Amendment. There
appeared for his Amendment fourteen,
against it eighty two. The Speakers on
each side were very few, & very short,
and the House was adjourned before
six o'clock. Mr. Fox has agreeably

to your Majesty's Orders, written as
Postscript to his dispatch to J^r James
Harris informing him of the substance of
the Intelligence this day received from
Holland.
