His Majesty has found with Concern,  
that notwithstanding the two several  
Payments of the Civil List Debt, and the  
subsequent increase of the Civil List  
Revenue, that a considerable Debt is  
since incurred. His Majesty therefore  
desires the Advice and Aid of the House  
of Commons as to the proposed mode  
of discharging that Debt, and preventing  
the like in future without laying any  
new burthens on His People, whom it is ever  
His wish, as much as possible to relieve.  
For these purposes His Majesty lays before  
the House the Plan of reform which  
He has judged proper to make, in  
His Establishments to be perfected by  
the Wisdom of Parliament for the  
Honour of the Crown and the Public  
Benefit.
