Lord Keppel has the honour to transmit to your Majesty, a  
despatch received this morning from Sir Thomas Pige, the wind being  
easterly prevents the ships off the shore from sailing. a messenger will be  
immediately sent to plymouth to hasten the suffolk, and also another  
messenger to the Downs to send the parishes to join Lord Howe  
Lord Keppel has the honour to assure your Majesty, that no attention  
shall be wanting in collecting the force in port that was not in readiness  
or condition to sail with Lord Howe.
