Lord Grantham begs to submit to your Majesty whether he should not dispatch a Messenger to Brussels to apprise Mr Tiphherbert of your Majesty's gracious Intention of commanding his Services at Paris, & submits also the Draft for that purpose for your Majesty's Approbation
