I have the satisfaction of stating to your Majesty with the fullest confidence of truth, that Miss Knight most solemnly declares that Her Majesty Highness has never



written a line to the Duke of Devonshire  
 or stopped at this wish in her life  
 or sent any wife of hers - & that  
 the Royal Highness never did stop  
 any carriage in the Park; for by  
 the elements was delayed by the  
 crowd, & did not remain near the  
 Royal Highness above 5 minutes.  
 No gentlemen have ever visited  
 the Princess at Warwick House  
 since Miss Thraight & I, have had  
 the honor of being with the Royal  
 Highness, & Mr Adam was sent  
 merely to convey a letter to your  
 Royal Highness that the Princess  
 received to be one of the King's  
 would have had the honor of visiting  
 her to your Royal Highness yesterday
