The King encloses to the Lord Chancellor His Instructions as to the Language he is, if the Prince of Wales is in Town, to hold to Him on the subject of His Majesty's Grand Daughter; or if absent, which the Lord Chancellor is to write in The King's Name to the Prince of Wales. His Majesty trusts He has stated the whole in so clear and concise a Manner, that farther Explanation from Him cannot be necessary.
