His Majesty has seen General Gualth who has acquainted Him, that, with every Assurance of Duty and Respect, Miss Gualth persists in declining the Situation offered to Her, in which She states that neither Her Spirit or Her Health, nor, in Her own Opinion, Her Abilities are competent.
